DIRECTOR'S BOX


Dear Arbitrators.

TIPS FOR MEANINGFUL HEARINGS:

- ** Make sure everyone is introduced.
- ** <u>Listen to everyone.</u> Everyone gets a chance to speak and be heard. Sometimes victims need to vent, you decide how long is appropriate, but everyone gets a chance to speak.
- ** It is <u>not mandatory</u> for the Officer or the Victim to attend. If they are not present then you must become the spokesman for the victim. Every crime has a victim; the youngster must attempt to understand this through your words if the victim is not there.
- ** <u>Juveniles 12 to 14 are very hard to place</u> at community service sites. Please ask a parent or guardian if they are a member of a Church where their youngster could work if they are under 14 years of age.
